

Saint-Auvent Grocery Store Survey

A group of residents from the town of Saint-Auvent is working on a project for a community grocery store run, at least initially, by volunteers, to compensate for the closure of the Vival store on May 1, 2023. It would primarily offer local products, bulk items, and "emergency" items not available locally (toilet paper, for example). We would like to include a coffee/tea room area and offer activities (with producers, artisans, local associations, and anything else the volunteers might be willing to offer).

Through this project, we aim to offer a service to the public and visitors, but also an opportunity for producers to improve their livelihoods by providing greater visibility for their products and an additional point of sale.

The range of products offered by local producers and artisans is extensive in Saint-Auvent and the surrounding area and can be supplemented with products from a little further afield. Within a radius of less than 15 km, you can find: vegetables, eggs, cheese, bread, meat, flour, honey, jam, oil, vinegar, sauces, beverages, pastries, milk, yogurt, butter, fruit, soaps, herbal teas, ceramics, and couture creations. And if you expand a little further, you can also find pasta, dried vegetables, and fruit within a 100 km radius.
